

Silver jubilee year DCSEM DAY 2022 held on 31.5.2022.

DCSEM was formed on June 1 1996 and completed 25 years in June 2021. The Silver Jubilee of DCSEM was celebrated on 31.05.2022 at DAE Convention Centre in Anushaktinagar. The day long celebrations were spread over three diverse sessions namely Inaugural session, Technical session and Variety entertainment program.

Inaugural session program - 09.45 am to 11.15am:

Shri K N Vyas, Secretary DAE & Chairman AEC was the Chief Guest for the function and Shri B C Pathak CMD NPCIL was the Guest of Honour for the opening session. In this opening address Shri B K Jain, Director, DCSEM elaborated on DCSEM's Journey as it grew through more than two decades of milestones and achievements. He mentioned about some of the major Infrastructure Projects like NISER, GCNEP, ICTCS, Medical Cyclotron, FRET etc. and laurels they brought to DCSEM. He spoke about grit and determination of DCSEM in overcoming challenges faced like ban on quarrying of sand, getting statutory approvals, Covid pandemic etc. He also highlighted the recent developmental works executed under Swachh Bahrat Abhiyan, upcoming projects and road map for converting Anushaktinagar to clean Green & Smart City. DCSEM 's book titled "Nirman" was also released on the occasion.

Guest of Honour Shri B C Pathak congratulated DCSEM on their eventful 25 years. He particularly appreciated the work

done by DCSEM in beautification of Anushaktinagar. He drew parallel & compared DCSEM as Lord Vishwakarma for DAE. Shri K N Vyas, Secretary DAE in his address congratulated DCSEM on this landmark event. He stressed upon global nature and importance of Projects like GCNEP, Infrastructure for which is developed by DCSEM.
