

Inauguration of D.A.E. Cultural centre, 'इंद्रधनुष - Indradhanush'

The facility was inaugurated on 23rd February 2020, by Shri K. N. Vyas, Chairman, Atomic Energy Commission & Secretary, Department of Atomic Energy in presence of Dr. A. K. Mohanty, Director, BARC & Shri B. K. Jain, Director, DCS&EM. Senior Officials of various DAE units, representatives of several active associations were present at the inaugural ceremony.

The Ground +1 structure comprises of 19 halls of 29 m² carpet area and 2 big halls with 60 m² carpet area. Along with all the common facilities e.g. toilets, staircase & parking. The premises also have a big developed area of about 650 m², for gatherings. The premises have been beautifully landscaped with flowering plants & lush green garden.
