

Brief Report On Plogging

DCSEM organized Swachhata Pakhwada-2023 during the period from 16th Feb. up to 28 th Feb.-2023. During this period various activities/events related to Swachhata were conducted. One of the important events was the plogging run in Anushaktinagar. This plogging event was conducted on 26th Feb.2023 from 7.30 am in the morning up to 8.45 am. In the plogging event the secondary students of all the Atomic Energy Central Schools and Junior college in Anushaktinagar, principals, Vice-Principals and other teachers of AECS, Students of HBNI, Trainees of BARC training school, Office bearers of ARWA, MARWA and western sector resident's association, DCSEM staffs and senior dignitaries of DAE participated under the leadership of Chairman, AEC and Secretary DAE.

As per the plan, all the participating students from a particular school/Jr. college were divided into six groups. All the groups were provided with coordinators from DCSEM and school side. The six groups were also given particular building premises for conducting the plogging run. Logistic supports like Masks, Gloves, Collection bags, First-aid box and water bottle etc were also provided to each group. DCSEM staffs and dignitaries from DAE had also joined different groups from different schools.

All the students reported at their respective school/Jr college at 7.0 am.

2023 was taken by all the participants at around 7.25 am and then all the groups started plogging run from their allotted building premises and gradually moved towards the Jr. College ground.

Students of HBNI and BARC trainees also participated in the plogging event. More than 1000 people participated in the plogging run including 700 students and trainees.

The concluding ceremony of plogging event was arranged at Jr. college ground at around 9.30 am after all the participants reached the ground from their respective plogging areas. Transport services was also arranged for participants of AECS No. 5 and AECS No 6. for reaching the JC ground.

Chairman, AEC and secretary DAE, Director, DCSEM and Chief Co-ordinator, Swachhata action plan, DCSEM, addressed the gathering highlighting the importance of Swachhata in our daily life. The dignitaries thanked all the participants for their co-operation and involvement.

Refreshment packets and water bottles were distributed to all those gathered at the JC ground and attended the function. It is also proposed to issue all the students the certificate of appreciation of their active participation.
